Employment Terms

The successful candidate will have the opportunity to be employed for an initial period of 6 months, which can be renewed for a longer period depending on the students' performance and availability. The first 6 months will be a trial period.

The student will be allocated space to work and will be required to have a physical presence at KIOS CoE during their work hours.

The employment status will be part-time with a maximum working time of 20 hours per week during the academic year of the University of Cyprus and 35 hours per week during the holiday periods at the University of Cyprus, with gross salary 7,15 €/hour. Various contributions (social insurance, etc.) will be deducted from the gross salary, in accordance with the existing legislation.
